INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENT +3 VOUCHERS:


- All UA institutions, except for Queens Botanical Garden and New York Botanical Garden (Bronx), require advance timed-entry reservations. Please see instructions below, under each institution, for instructions on how to reserve your timed entry tickets.
- 2. Most UA institutions require that you show your tickets. Once you reserve your timed entry tickets you should receive an email with admission information.
- 3. Each voucher admits 4 people, you can reuse your UA voucher, and more than 4 people may be admitted at one time by reusing the voucher.
- 4. Voucher does not include parking at UA institutions, except at the Staten Island Zoo.

American Museum of Natural History

Valid for general admission and one special exhibit. To use the voucher, call AMNH Central Reservations at (212) 769-5200 in advance (prior to your visit date) to reserve a timed entry. You will need to provide your Voucher ID Number during this call. To cancel, call (212) 769-5200 by 5 pm the day prior to your visit or UA voucher will be rendered void for future use.

Brooklyn Botanic Garden

Valid for general admission. Children under 14 must be supervised by adults 18 or over. Advanced timed-entry tickets required to enter the Garden. To use the voucher, visit: https://www.bbg.org/visit to reserve your date and time of entry. Click "Get Tickets" then click "Not a Member, Buy Tickets" (no fee will be charged). Select time and date and choose "Affiliated Organization Tickets" on the Reserve Tickets Menu. Go to "Checkout". You will receive a confirmation email with QR code that you must show on arrival. You must bring your UA "Student + 3" voucher (either paper or digital copy) to show to Visitor Services staff.

New York Aquarium

Valid for general admission. Parking not included. To use this voucher, visit wcs.education/ua-store in order to reserve your date and time of entry. You will need to provide your Voucher ID Number and school name when reserving your tickets online. Once you have reserved online, you will receive your tickets in a separate email, which you will present on your mobile device at the admission booth at your reserved date and time.

New York Botanical Garden

Valid for daytime access to NYBG's outdoor gardens and collections (does not provide admission to the Enid A. Haupt Conservatory, the Holiday Train Show, and other special exhibitions). Parking not included. To use the voucher, visit NYBG and present your UA "Student + 3" voucher (either paper or digital copy) to a visitor services representative at a ticket booth. You will receive the next available Garden Pass with timed entry.

New York Hall of Science

Valid for general admission. Parking not included. To use this voucher, visit nysci.org/tickets in order to reserve your date and time of entry. You will need to provide your **Voucher ID Number** when reserving your tickets online. Once you have reserved online, you will receive your tickets in a separate email, which you will present on your mobile device at the admission area at your reserved date and time.

Staten Island Zoo

Valid for admission to all exhibits. To use your UA voucher, please visit http://www.statenislandzoo.org/tickets/. Click on the "Urban Advantage Admissions Tickets" button. Select the amount of guests you'd like to bring with you during your visit under the drop down option entitled "Urban Advantage Tickets Covered By Voucher (Max 4)". Additional guests can be covered by placing another reservation using the same voucher number. You will be asked to provide your Voucher ID, Teacher Name, and School Name before checkout. You must present your UA "Student + 3" voucher (either by paper or with a digital copy) at the admissions gate upon arrival. Free parking is available. UA "Student + 3" vouchers may also be used for a live, interactive 15-minute "Virtual Animal Drop-In" with a Zoo educator and animal of your choice. Reservations are required at least 5 days in advance and are made at http://www.statenislandzoo.org/virtual-zoo/. If using your UA voucher for a Virtual Animal Drop-In, use the discount code "UAS+3" (case sensitive) at checkout to apply your redemption discount. You will be prompted to provide your voucher ID number.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CLASS TRIP VOUCHERS:

- 1. Class trip vouchers expire on JUne 30th, 2022.
- This year, UA school groups will be able to visit UA institutions and book online (virtual) class programs.
- 3. Not all UA institutions offer in-person group visits and online experiences that are free with a UA class trip voucher. To get up-to-date information on which institutions offer these fee-based experiences for school groups and descriptions of programs, be sure to check back regularly and review this document for updates.
- 4. Voucher ID numbers must be presented to book class trips to UA institutions or online programs. Please be sure you have your Class Trip voucher ID number with you at the time you make your reservation.

American Museum of Natural History

Valid Wednesday through Friday only. To reserve a timed entry, call AMNH Central Reservations at (212) 769-5200. You will need to provide your Voucher ID Number during this call. To cancel, call (212) 769-5200 by 5 pm the day prior to your visit or UA voucher will be rendered void for future use. Valid for general admission, Special Exhibits, and choice of one of the following: IMAX, Space Show. Registration required. Parking not included.

Groups visiting with 'Class Trip' and 'School Community Trip' Vouchers must check in with a museum representative at either (1) the school reception area, or (2) 81st Street ticketing desks.

What can I do with my voucher?

Programs at the AMNH are in person and on site, only. Valid for general admission, Special Exhibits, and choice of one of the following: IMAX, Space Show.


Bronx Zoo

Brooklyn Botanic Garden

UA Class Trip Vouchers can be used for School Workshops/Virtual Field Trips to Brooklyn Botanic Garden. Virtual field trips include a 60-minute, live, BBG instructor—led experience consisting of prerecorded video tours and an interactive lesson. Choose from two topics: Tropical and Desert Plant Explorations (pre-K—8) and Exploring Plants in Our Lives (K—8). Teachers will set up the virtual field trip using the platform of their choice. Teachers will be mailed a kit including plants and potting-up materials for the class. Access to online materials and a potting-up video tutorial for teachers included. COVID Health and Safety Requirements for visiting UA partner institutions

AMNH: Health and Safety at AMNH During COVID-19

In accordance with the New York City <u>vaccine requirement</u>, you must be vaccinated against **COVID-19** to enter AMNH. Beginning Wednesday, August 25 visitors ages 12 and older must show proof of vaccination.

Personal identification with name and photo or date of birth is also required for visitors ages 18 and over. Examples of accepted forms of identification include driver's license, non-driver government ID card, passport, or school ID card.

Proof of vaccination may include:

- NYC COVID Safe App: <u>Android</u> | <u>iOS</u>
- Excelsior Pass
- CDC Vaccination Card (or photo)
- NYC Vaccination Record
- An official immunization record from outside NYC or the U.S

If you received the vaccine outside the U.S., you must have an official immunization record that includes:

- First name and last name
- Date of birth
- Vaccine product name (only vaccines authorized by the <u>FDA</u> or <u>WHO</u> are acceptable)
- Date(s) administered
- Site where the vaccine was administered, or name of the person who administered it.

The health and safety of visitors and staff is a top priority. A number of changes have been made to <u>ticketing and operating procedures</u> based on guidance from public health authorities such as the <u>Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)</u> and appropriate government agencies.

SIZ: Health and Safety at SIZ During COVID-19

As of September 13th, and in accordance with New York City Executive order No. 225, COVID-19 vaccinations will be required for all guests 12+ to enter the Zoo. Masks are required while visiting all indoor exhibits, our Zoo café, and any indoor facility, such as our auditorium, events tent, and restrooms. Online reservations will also be required for admission.

Children 11 years and younger are permitted to enter the Zoo with a vaccinated adult chaperone.

Guests 18+ must also show an official form of identification with name and photo or date of birth, such as a driver's license, non-driver government ID, IDNYC, passport, or School ID.

Proof of vaccination (at least 1 shot) may include:

- NYC COVID Safe App: <u>Android</u> | <u>iOS</u>
- Excelsior Pass
- CDC Vaccination Card (or photo)
- NYC Vaccination Record
- An official immunization record from outside NYC or the U.S

Queens Botanical Garden is a mostly outdoor facility. At this time, vaccinated visitors and staff are not required to wear masks outdoors, regardless of distancing. Individuals may choose to still wear masks.

Our indoor spaces include: the QBG Store, indoor wedding spaces, classrooms, and the Visitor & Administration Building Gallery. To ensure the health and safety of our staff, visitors, and community members, Queens Botanical Garden is required to implement Mayor Bill de Blasio's Emergency Executive Order 225 and vaccine mandate, Key to NYC, which requires people 12 years of age and older to show proof of COVID-19 vaccination for indoor entertainment, recreation, dining, and fitness settings.

Proof of vaccination (at least 1 shot) may include:

- NYC COVID Safe App: <u>Android</u> | <u>iOS</u>
- Excelsior Pass
- CDC Vaccination Card (or photo)
- NYC Vaccination Record
- An official immunization record from outside NYC or the U.S

Personal identification with name and photo or date of birth is also required for visitors ages 18 and over. Examples of accepted forms of identification include driver's license, non-driver government ID card, passport, or school ID card.

Masks must also be worn while indoors.

Individuals planning to enter our buildings for a prolonged stay (more than 15 minutes), should do a self-assessment before arrival. If any of the answers to the question below is "yes," the visitor should stay home:

- 1. Have I experienced in the last 48 hours, any new or worsening COVID-19 symptoms?
- 2. If unvaccinated, have I had close contact (being within six feet for at least 10 minutes over a 24-hour period) or proximate contact (as determined by health authorities) in the past 10 days with any person confirmed by diagnostic test, or suspected based on symptoms, to have COVID-19?
- 3. Have I tested positive through a diagnostic test for COVID-19 in the past 10 days?
