

How to use the Urban Advantage School Community Trip Voucher

Parent coordinators will receive two vouchers to use for field trips on **weekends and school holidays**. Each voucher is good for up to 40 individuals (including UA students, family members and chaperones). If there are more than 40 visitors, an additional voucher must be used. Vouchers expire on **June 30, 2019**. Free buses are available to use for School Community Field Trips along with Expo and Family Science Sunday. **Please note that School Community Vouchers CANNOT be used on EXPO Day (June 1st, 2019).**

- Determine your trip destination and date.
- Call the UA institution to make your reservation. Need more information? Refer to the School Community Trip Planning Packet.
 - Ask your customer service representative:
 - About booking any special events or exhibits.
 - About parking fees and/or availability.
 - About reserving space for lunch.
 - About any exhibit closings.
- Write your trip reservation number on your voucher for easy reference.
- Reserve your free UA bus through <https://myua.amnh.org> or check www.mta.info for changes and updates on public transportation. You may also be eligible for weekend MTA passes through your CBO; ask your administrator.
- Please check in with your school kitchen about bagged lunch options. The School Community Trip Planning Packet also has lunch options at each institution.
